## HENDERSON BOAT LIFTERS HIGHLIGHTED RULES AND REGULATIONS

### **THIS IS AN INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY - HENDERSON BOAT LIFTERS AND WORKSAFE WA CONDUCT REGULAR INSPECTIONS.**

**These rules and regulations must be followed and abided by at all times during the duration of your stay at Henderson Boat Lifters.**

**\* All contractors must be inducted prior to any work commencing of any clients vessel. The client must notify Henderson Boat Lifters when a new contractor will be entering the yard so that an induction can be organised prior to work commencing.**

\* All contractor equipment will be checked to ensure it is in safe working order prior to any work commencing at Henderson Boat Lifters. Regular checks on contractor equipment will be made.

**\* Any person being paid to work on vessels must hold a construction white card.**

\* Please ensure that all rubbish has been taken away when the vessel leaves the premises. A fee will be charged and added to the vessel's account to cover cleaning costs or damage caused by vessel owners or their contractors.

\* Any items removed from the vessel, such as booms, masts, brine tanks, winches anchors and chains etc., may not be left in the yard after the vessel is refloated without the prior permission of the yard management. A storage fee will apply to any items left. Abandoned items, or any item left without management approval will be disposed of and any associated costs will be invoiced to the vessel owner.

**\* Abrasive blasting and spray painting on Henderson Boat Lifters property may only be carried out in the workshop by Henderson Boat Lifters or their contractors. In the open air Henderson Boat Lifters is restricted to painting by either airless spray, roller or brush only.**

\* 24 hours notice is required for refloats. Requests for weekend or public holiday refloats will be considered if sufficient notice is given and a penalty rate will be applied to cover the costs.

\* Unless prior arrangements are made well in advance all accounts are to be paid in full prior to the vessel being lifted for refloat. Lifter staff are not authorised to make exceptions so please do not ask, as refusal often causes offence or embarrassment.

\* For vessel remaining in the yard for extended periods, invoices will be issued at the end of each Month. These must be settled within 7 days. Overdue accounts will attract appropriate interest charges.

\* Extra Lifts: Any extra lifts whilst vessel is on the hard stand for removal of rudders etc. will be charged additionally.

\* Hull inspections: Vessels requiring to be lifted for hull inspections will be charged at 50% of the normal lift and launch rate for the applicable sized vessel and a maximum time limit of 1 hour will apply.

**\* No Alcohol or drugs are to be consumed or are permitted at the Henderson Boat Lifters site at any time.**

**\* Please ensure you wear the appropriate foot protection and any other relevant safety equipment as required during the time of your visit.**

\* Only essential work vehicles are permitted into the HBL yard. All other vehicles must be parked in parking areas at the top of the yard on Clarence Beach Road. Note: No responsibility will be taken for any damage to a vehicle while on Henderson Boat Lifters premises.

\* Vehicles that are allowed yard access must submit details to HBL and obtain a parking permit. The parking permits must be displayed and returned at the completion of your stay at Henderson Boat Lifters. A fee will be charged for any permits not returned.

\* Any vehicles found to be driving in excess of the yard speed limit or in an erratic manner may be banned indefinitely from entering the yard.

\* Henderson Boat Lifters holds the right to refuse lifting any clients vessel under any circumstance.
